This letter is written to inform the California Coastal Commission that the California Department of Parks and Recreation intends to process a Right-of-Entry Permit for the Cambria Community Services District allowing the CCSD, or their agents, access onto state park property for the geotechnical investigation on Hearst San Simeon State Park on the strand within the Santa Rosa Creek Day Use Area. Prior to Right-of-Entry approval, copies of all pertinent local, state and federal permits and conditions are required to be submitted to the Department. The Departmental ROE process requires review by the Office of Acquisition and Real Property in Sacramento and an individual CEQA determination.
